Dear Ms. Bose:

Trunkline LNG Company, LLC (TLNG) submits this filing pursuant to Section 21 of the General Terms and Conditions of TLNG's FERC Gas Tariff, Third Revised Volume No. 1-A (Section 21). An original and five (5) copies are included herewith.

Section 21 provides for the flow-through of all penalty revenues collected, net of cost, (Miscellaneous Revenue Amount) to shippers under Rate Schedules FTS, FTS-2, ITS and ITS-2 by means of a surcharge adjustment to the base reservation and usage rates (Miscellaneous Revenue Flowthrough Surcharge Adjustment). The effective date of each Miscellaneous Revenue Flowthrough Surcharge Adjustment is August 1, 2010.

In accordance with Section 21, the Miscellaneous Revenue Amount shall be determined four (4) months prior to August 1, 2010. No penalty revenues have been billed or collected during this period. Consequently, there is no adjustment necessary to TLNG's base reservation and usage rates.
